STUDENTS 19 YEARS OLD OF AGE AND OLDER MAY HOLD THE LEARNER'S PERMIT FOR 30 DAYS IN ORDER OF COMPLETING A DRIVING TRAINING COURSE.

Students less than 18 years of age and under are required to complete a state approved Driver Education Program prior to receiving a Drivers License. Which contain of thirty-six 50 min. periods of classroom and seven 50 min. periods of Driving and seven 50 min. periods of observation (observing another student while they drive). The last driving session will be the Driving Test. We must have two students in vehicle for driving instruction. In car instruction should not exceed 2 period of driving in 24 hours. We have 6 months to provide the behind the wheel instruction. Upon successful completion of course we have 5 business days to issue a 180 day temporary license. The actual term "CTD-B". Student within 180 days should receive a court hearing to pick up a hard copy Driver license. It is the parent's responsibility to contact the driving school if he or she hasn't received the court hearing one week before temporary license expired.

EXTENDED PERIODS OF INTRUCTION ALLOWS STUDENTS ENROLLED IN PUBLIC OR NONPUBLIC/PRIVATE EDUVATION SCHOOLS

This policy change allows students enrolled in public or nonpublic/private education schools and completing driver education through a Commercial Driving Training School, to receive for (4) periods of instruction on weekends and holidays. A class period defined as fifty (50) minutes.

During this time, instruction should not exceed a total of four (4) period for classroom instruction or more than two (2) periods of Classroom instruction and two (2) period of in-car instruction (one period driving and one period of observation) within any twenty four (24) hour. For schools, the decision to observed the extended four (4) periods of instruction schedule on weekends/holidays should be made by the parent/student and the instructor.

EXTENDED PERIOD OF INSTRUCTION/STUDENTS NOT ENROLLED IN PUBLIC OR NONPUBLIC/PRIVATE EDUCATION SCHOOL

For students not enrolled in public or nonpublic/private education schools and completing driver education through a Commercial Driver Training School. This policy allow students to receive four (4) periods of instruction on weekdays/weekends and holidays. A class period is defined as fifty (50) minutes.

Instruction should not exceed total of (4) periods for classroom or no more than two (2) periods of in-car within any twenty four (24) hour period. The last driving period will be the driving test. We must have 2 students in the vehicle at all times. We have 6 months to provide behind the wheel instruction.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

All payments are due the first day of class in form of check, cash, or money order.

The classroom program consists of 36 (50 minute) periods in class. Behind the wheel consist of 7 (50 minute) periods of observing another driver. The 7th driving period is the driving test.

The Fee for Classroom Instruction is \$ 200.00

The Fee for Behind The Wheel is \$ 280.00

The Fee for Classroom and Behind the Wheel is \$ 425.00

ADDITIONAL CHARGES:

- Return check fee \$25.00
- Additional Driving sessions will be \$ 45.00 per session.
- If student retakes driving test will be a \$ 35.00 make up fee.
- Cancellation fee: you must cancel behind the wheel or classroom session 24 hour in advance. If not you will be charged \$50.00 per session that needs to be made up.

REFUNDS:

If a refund is requested we will deduct \$ 35.00 per 50 minute classroom, behind the wheel, or observation sessions, unless the school is capable or willing to perform its part of the contract within reasonable time period. You must submit a letter in writing; your refund will be mailed within 30 days after your letter is received. Refund will be made by mail only.

SCHEDULING DRIVING APPOINTMENTS

It is parent’s responsibility to call to make driving appointments, during business hours. Students should call our business line to schedule appointments that is (703) 892-2222. Our business appointments are Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday 11:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. and Wednesday 10.00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. We are closed on the weekends. Messages left on our voice mail on the weekend will be returned on the next business day. Students have 6 months to complete Driver Education Course.
